**Open to Concord residents only. No dealers.** Bring things you don't want, take away things you can use. Everything is free. **All items must be in good working order. No items can be dropped after 12:30 P.M.**

**AREA - B**

**BIKES**—All kinds. Bikes to be set aside for future Concord Bike Giveaway. Date TBA.  
**\*Bikes also accepted at SwapOff.**

**ELECTRONICS**—Televisions, computers, monitors, printers, keyboards, fax machines, VCRs, stereo equipment, etc. Please remove personal information.(\$)

**HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND FURNITURE**—Towels, linens, pots & pans, dish sets, flatware, etc. for HGRM

**PAPER SHREDDING** — Per box (approx. 9” x 11” x 17”). No limit. Call (978) 318-3240 for questions or additional information.(\$)

**REUSABLE BUILDING MATERIALS**—In good condition: cabinets, unpainted doors and windows, plumbing & light fixtures, flooring (wood, tile, sheet vinyl), lumber, plywood, sheetrock (16 SF and up).

**UNWANTED MEDICATIONS & SHARPS** — (needles & syringes) . Must be in sealed container. Call (978) 318-3240 for more info. (\$Voluntary Contributions gratefully accepted.).

**AREA - C**

**CARPETING**—Carpeting and foam padding. (\$)

**BULKY PLASTICS**—playhouses, coolers, etc. (\$)

**MATTRESSES & BOXSPRINGS** (\$)

**OVERSIZED WASTE**—Large items too large to set out in the trash (these items are not recycled). (\$)

**UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE**—Sofas, sofa beds, loveseats, armchairs, etc. Items are recycled. (\$)

**SCRAP METAL AND APPLIANCES**—Appliances, air conditioners, gas grills, propane tanks, (lawn mowers & snow blowers: fuel & oil removed), metal pipe, chain link fence, lawn chairs, nails and other items containing at least 75% metal. (\$)

**AREA - D**

**SNEAKERS & SHOES**—For reuse and recycling.



**BOOKS**—Books in any condition will be given to “More Than Words” for reuse or recycling. Please donate high quality books directly to the Concord Free Public Library on Main Street.

**CDs, DVDs, \*VHS** (\*\$10 per box for VHS tapes. Cash or check payable to More Than Words).

**CELL PHONES**—with or without chargers.

**CRAYONS**—Old crayons.



**FLUORESCENT & LED BULBS**—Any length or shape.

**HEARING AIDS**—working & nonworking

**HOLIDAY LIGHTS** —LED & incandescent

**LAPTOP COMPUTERS**—Working Only Also accepted at SwapOff.

**PRINTER CARTRIDGES**—Inkjet, laser, fax, etc.

**RECHARGEABLE & SPECIALTY BATTERIES**—Rechargeable (Ni-Cad), lithium/button. (No alkaline or lead acid batteries).

**STYROFOAM** —Clean styrofoam block (\$). Take peanuts to shipping stores.

**RAGS, TEXTILES & TOWELS**—Old, clean towels, linens, fabric, bedspreads, curtains, clothing and rags for reuse & recycling.

**TEFLON**—POTS & PANS.

# SwapOff Guidelines

## If you are bringing items for SwapOff:

- **Please deliver items by 12:30 P.M.**—nothing accepted after that time. Browsing permitted until 2:00.
- **NO PARKING**—you must remain with vehicle while volunteers assist with unloading. Spaces are for unloading only.
- **Call (978) 318-3240 after 7:30 A.M. to see if rain cancels the event—if so, please save items for next SwapOff or donate to charity.**
- **Bring only CLEAN items in good working order.** You will be asked to provide your name and address when dropping off large items—you will be billed if the items are not taken. You may claim unwanted items before 1 P.M.

**THE FOLLOWING ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT SwapOff:** *Bulky items that require more than one person to carry*. Tube TVs & Cathode Ray Tube Monitors (EXCEPTION: Flat panel TVs & monitors OKAY), outdated or oversized athletic equipment, children’s car seats, air conditioners, skis, **furniture & rugs**. Call Concord Public Works at (978) 318-3240 for recycling options for items not accepted at SwapOff.

## If you are taking items from SwapOff:

- **Concord Residents Only** (This restriction is necessary to control the number of people who come to this very well-attended event).
- **Only volunteers may help unload vehicles.**
- **Please do not stay longer than one hour, and please don’t hover by the entrance or the vehicle unloading areas. Take only what you can carry. No accumulating piles. Limit of 1 large item and three small items per person.**

 Weather Dependent. Rain (on Friday or projected rain for Saturday) could cancel early SwapOff. If questionable, call (978) 318-3240 for update. No browsing.

**Electronics Recycling.....32cents/lb.**

Keyboard, answering machine, etc. ....\$3

Inkjet printer, fax, VCR, laptop, scanner.....\$5

CPU.....\$12

TV—Small (under 25”), monitor, CPU.....\$20

TV—Medium (25” - 30”).....\$25

Larger TV’s, copiers, lg printers, etc.....\$32/100 lbs.

**Paper Shredding (per box).....\$6**

**Mattress Recycling**

**Mattress, Box Spring, Futons.....\$22 ea**

**Crib Mattress.....\$12**

**Oversized Waste** (about \$14/cubic yard or \$10/100 lbs)

Prices are average—Extra charge for heavier items.

Car trunk or back seat full..... \$12-\$14

Station wagon/SUV (depending on how full)...\$20-\$25

Van or pickup (depending on how full).....\$45-\$65

**Toilets & porcelain sinks.....\$17**

**Concrete Blocks, heavy items, etc. \$14/100 lbs**

**Scrap Metal Recycling (about \$8 per cubic yd)**

**(Any item that is almost all metal)**

**Small Amount (less than recycling bin)..FREE**

**Medium Amount.....\$3**

**Large Items.....\$5**

Lawn Mower (fuel & oil removed).....\$5

Snow Blower (fuel & oil removed).....\$5

**Large Appliances**

White Goods, Air Conditioners,

Water Heaters.....\$12-\$20

**Propane Tanks (empty or full).....\$2-\$6**

**Styrofoam Block Recycling..... \$6/trash bag**

**Upholstered Furniture Recycling**

Office Chair.....\$12

Arm Chair.....\$20

Loveseat, sofa or sleep sofa..... \$25

Foam cushions (separate).....\$3
