

Water Main Leak Detection Services Starts December 16th

As a part of the Water and Sewer Division's preventive maintenance program, electronic water main leak detection will be performed by Jim from Liston Utility Services. Leak detection should not cause any water quality upsets and you can continue to use your water as normal.

Electronic leak detection has the ability to pin point very small water leaks that could otherwise go unnoticed for long periods of time. The electronic leak detection will be completed during the day starting on December 16th and will take approximately 10 days to complete. In the area being surveyed there will be yellow bags, as seen below, placed over the hydrants being used for the survey.



You will see a number of these bags in the area being surveyed. Please be aware that the fire hydrant is still operational and no water quality disturbances are anticipated during leak detection. Once the survey in the area is complete Jim remove the yellow bags.

Each year Concord surveys approximately half of the water mains, this year the section north of Route 2 will be surveyed.
