Adopt-A-Light Program

Thanks for your interest in Concord's Adopt-A-Light Program! As you may know, the Town of Concord is deactivating all streetlights except those that already exist at road intersections, busy commercial and residential areas, railroad crossings, and significant curves in the roads. The Board of Selectmen approved these measures to cut expenses and save approximately \$35K in expenses per year.

Concord Light developed the Adopt-A-Light Program to allow interested residents an opportunity to "adopt" a light and keep the streetlight illuminated from dusk to dawn. For a monthly adoption fee, Concord Light will furnish a 50-watt metal halide lighting fixture for a minimum of two (2) years.

I'm interested! How can I adopt a streetlight?

To adopt a streetlight, you can print and complete the Adopt-A-Light Program application form found on our website http://www.concordma.gov/pages/ConcordMA_LightPlant/forms. You can also call Customer Service at Concord Light to have an application form sent to you. Once you've completed the form, either mail or bring it to Concord Light to be enrolled in the program.

How soon will my adopted light be installed?

After we receive and process your application, we will install your adopted light as soon as the work can be scheduled – normally one to two weeks.

What are the adoption fees?

The adoption fee for each street light fixture is \$17.00 per month. This fee will be included on your regular electric statement.

What if more than one customer wants to adopt the same light?

If two or more customers want to share the cost of adopting a light, one of the customers in the group will be responsible for collecting from the others. Concord Light will bill only one customer account for the adoption fees.

Who takes care of maintenance of an adopted streetlight?

Concord Light will operate and maintain the streetlight; however, once you adopt a streetlight, you are responsible for notifying Concord Light of repairs or maintenance needed by calling 978-318-3101. Please remember to tell the customer service representative that the streetlight is an adopted light.

How do I know if a streetlight is adopted?

Adopted streetlights are identified by a small brass plaque stating "Adopt-A-Light."
